MVP Update

The Shawnee Mission School District (SMSD) strongly encourages volunteer support for students and schools. It is equally committed to the safety of students and volunteers. To support the goal of safety, the district has instituted a policy requiring background records checks for all volunteers.

In order to make the process more efficient and effective, on September 24, 2018, the Shawnee Mission Board of Education (BOE) approved the use of Validity Screening Solutions to provide background screenings for MVP volunteers. This new background screening process will take the place of the current fingerprinting requirement for MVP volunteers. Instead of coming to the Center for Academic Achievement, MVP volunteers will go on-line to enter the required information.

There are now two steps required to complete the MVP process:

- 1) Attend an in-person training
 - **a.** Visit https://www.smsd.org/families/volunteer-mvp for available sessions.
 - **b.** Note: Tuesday morning sessions at CAA require a reservation—seating is limited. Email <u>volunteer@smsd.org</u> for more information.
- 2) Visit Validity Screening to complete the online, background screening process.
 - **a.** If you have already completed the required training, visit this link to complete the process.

In most cases, applicants will be approved and ready to serve as a MVP volunteer within 48 hours.

Notes from Nurse Blizzard

The exclusion rules for Influenza have changed. The Johnson County Department of Health and Environment (JCDHE) is now recommending students with physician diagnosed Influenza be excluded from school for 7 days after the onset of symptoms, as this is the time period in which they are still contagious. If your child has been diagnosed with the flu, please remember to keep them home for 7 days after the onset of symptoms.



Lost and Found


Dear Mom & Dad,
