Kansas State Assessments

Every spring our students in grades 3-6 participate in Kansas State assessments for reading and math, as well as science for 5th grade students. Last year, due to COVID-19 school closures, the Kansas Department of Education made the decision to not administer state assessments. This spring, with schools being open, KSDE has made the decision to return to administering state assessments. KSDE has shared the expectation with school districts that they would like all students to take the state assessments. Students in grades 3rd-6th grade will be assessed in reading and math. Fifth graders will also be assessed in the area of science. Classroom teachers will communicate the details of your child's schedule.

R&D Forum

Cada primavera, nuestros estudiantes en los grados 3-6 participan en las evaluaciones del estado de Kansas para lectura y matemáticas, así como ciencias para los estudiantes de quinto grado. El año pasado, debido al cierre de escuelas COVID-19, el Departamento de Educación de Kansas tomó la decisión de no administrar las evaluaciones estatales. Esta primavera, con las escuelas abiertas, KSDE ha tomado la decisión de volver a administrar las evaluaciones estatales. KSDE ha compartido la expectativa con los distritos escolares de que les gustaría que todos los estudiantes tomen evaluaciones estatales. Los estudiantes de 3º a 6º grado serán evaluados en lectura y matemáticas. Los estudiantes de quinto grado también serán evaluados en el área de ciencias. Los maestros del salón de clases comunicarán los detalles del horario de su hijo.

- Continue individual and group meetings with students as space allows during this time, (including 1:1 & small group Webex meetings).
- Provide resources to parents struggling with emotional/behavioral issues at home.

Nuestros trabajadores sociales pueden ...

- Ayude a los estudiantes / familias con ansiedad, depresión, prevención del suicidio, relaciones con los compañeros y otras dinámicas familiares / escolares.
- Ayude a crear planes de apoyo al comportamiento con estudiantes / familias / maestros.
- Ayudar a los maestros con la enseñanza socioemocional y enfoques informados sobre el trauma en sus aulas
- Continúe las reuniones individuales y grupales con los estudiantes según lo permita el espacio durante este tiempo (incluidas las reuniones de Webex en grupos pequeños y 1: 1).

SMSD is offering **FREE meals to all SMSD students** regardless if they are learning remote, hybrid or in person. This includes seven (7) breakfast and seven (7) lunch meals for each student.

- Each breakfast meal includes fruit, grain and milk
- Each lunch meal includes protein, fruit/vegetable, grain and milk

Menus are available on the district web page by clicking [here](#) and are subject to change due to availability. All entrées and sides need to be taken home and refrigerated or frozen until ready to heat or consume.

Students will receive their in-person meals at no cost during the days they are in school. Meals may be picked up on Friday for the other 5 days of the week. Any extra ala carte purchases the students make while in-person learning will require money to be on their food service account.

Meals are prepared by District Food Services staff and distributed following food safety and sanitary practices. This program is funded entirely by USDA as part of their Summer Meals Program extension. These free meals will continue through the end of the 2020-2021 school year. We encourage families to continue to apply for free and reduced meals. Qualifying may allow for other support through the district.

Las comidas son financiadas en su totalidad por el USDA como parte de su extensión del Programa de Comidas de Verano. Estas comidas gratuitas continuarán hasta el final del año escolar. UBICACION DE RECOGIDA

Durante el aprendizaje a distancia, la recogida de cada semana incluirá 7 desayunos y 7 almuerzos para cada alumno.

- Cada comida del desayuno incluye estos componentes: fruta, cereales y leche.
- Cada comida del almuerzo incluye estos componentes: proteína, fruta/verdura, cereales y leche.

CONSEJOS DE SEGURIDAD ALIMENTARIA E INSTRUCCIONES PARA RECALENTAR

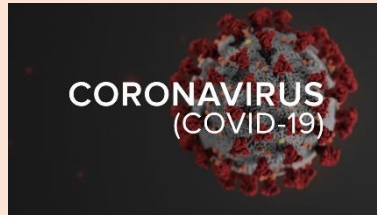
Cuando el distrito pueda pasar al modelo híbrido, los estudiantes recibirán sus comidas en persona sin costo alguno durante los dos días que estén en la escuela. Las comidas se pueden recoger los viernes para los otros 5 días de la semana. Cualquier compra extra a la carta que hagan los estudiantes mientras aprenden en persona requerirá dinero en su cuenta de servicio de alimentos.

The 3 W's

WEAR a Mask

- It is important that students have several masks that fit their face snug/no gaps, cover the nose and mouth, don't fall down, and do not have valves.
- Wear a mask when you are within 6 feet of others, even if you are outside.
- Don't forget to wear a mask if carpooling or walking within 6 feet of others.

WASH Your Hands

- Wash your hands often, especially before and after eating or using the restroom, after playing outside, and before putting on a mask or taking it off.
- Use hand sanitizer if you don't have access to soap and water.
- Scrub your hands for at least 20 seconds.

WATCH for Symptoms

- Check for symptoms of COVID-19 every day.
- Watch for fever, chills, cough, difficulty breathing, loss of taste/smell, headache, body aches, congestion, runny nose, nausea, diarrhea, vomiting, sore throat, fatigue.
- Stay home if you have any of the above signs/symptoms of illness.

The 3 C's

CONTACTS

- Limit the number of people you/your student are in contact with.
- Establish a small, static group of people for your student to interact with (cohort).
- Sleepovers, indoor parties, and gatherings with people outside of your cohort should be avoided.

CHOICES

- Make choices that keep you safe like social distancing, wearing a mask, cohorting, and hand washing.
- Think about any activity before engaging. Avoid large gatherings, outdoor activities are better as long as social distance is maintained. Avoid activities that require close/face to face interaction.
- Upon arriving home wash your hands immediately. Consider changing clothes, showering, leaving shoes outside.

CROWDS

- Avoid crowds/large gatherings.
- Stay at least 6 feet apart from others.
- Be aware of and avoid any unnecessary exposure opportunities. Avoid places where people are not wearing masks and social distancing.

PONTE LA MASCARA

- Es importante que los estudiantes tengan varias mascararas que esten ajustadas a su cara sin espacio, que cubran nariz y boca, no se baje y no tengan valvula.
- Ponte la mascara cuando estes a menos de 6 pies de distancia de otros, aun estando afuera.
- No se te olvide ponerte la mascara si te vas con otras personas en el carro o caminas con ellos y no hay 6 pies de distancia.

LAVATE LAS MANOS

BUSCA POR ESTOS SINTOMAS

- Verifique los síntomas de COVID-19 todos los días.
- Esté atento a fiebre, escalofríos, tos, dificultad para respirar, pérdida del gusto / olfato, dolor de cabeza, dolores corporales, congestión, secreción nasal, náuseas, diarrea, vómitos, dolor de garganta, fatiga.
- Quédese en casa si tiene alguno de los signos / síntomas de enfermedad anteriores

CONTACTOS

- Limite el número de personas con las que usted o su estudiante están en contacto.
- Establezca un grupo pequeño y estático de personas con las que su estudiante interactúe (cohorte).
- Deben evitarse las pijamadas, las fiestas en el interior y las reuniones con personas fuera de su cohorte.

DESICIONES

- Tome decisiones que lo mantengan seguro, como el distanciamiento social, el uso de una máscara, la cohorte y el lavado de manos.
- Piense en cualquier actividad antes de participar. Evite las reuniones grandes, las actividades al aire libre son mejores siempre que se mantenga la distancia social. Evite actividades que requieran una interacción cercana o cara a cara.
- Al llegar a casa lávese las manos inmediatamente. Considere cambiarse de ropa, ducharse, dejar los zapatos afuera.

MULTITUDES

- Evite las multitudes / grandes reuniones.
- Manténgase al menos a 6 pies de distancia de los demás.
- Tenga en cuenta y evite las oportunidades de exposición innecesarias. Evite los lugares donde las personas no usen máscaras y el distanciamiento social.
