PICKING UP or DROPPING OFF a student at Briarwood Elementary School?

Left turns onto Nall are prohibited during certain times on school day as indicated on signs.

- Please pull into parking lots as far as possible to allow other drivers to enter behind you.
- No left turn is allowed from 86th St to the East entrance of the Briarwood parking lot.
- Consider car-pooling, bicycling, or walking to and from school.
- If feasible, make plans for your student to walk to a pre-arranged location to be picked up.
- Handicapped accessible parking spots are for vehicles/drivers with the correct permits ONLY.
 They are not to be used for even a short time by able-bodied individuals. This violation carries a \$100 fine.
- Parking regulations are posted throughout the neighborhood and will be enforced.
- Driving in the opposing lane of traffic when leaving the school is unsafe and is a traffic violation.
- A common violation around schools is the failure of drivers to yield to pedestrians in crosswalks.

We need your voluntary compliance with the traffic regulations around Briarwood Elementary to ensure the safety of the students and to prevent accidents!!!

The Briarwood PTA is once again utilizing *My School Anywhere* for our Briarwood Directory and Parent Portal, which includes our online store that will be used for membership and event payments. *Please note:* This portal is separate from Skyward and the contact information given will be used for important PTA communications such as room parent emails and event announcements.

Returning families: Check your inbox for a confirmation email then update your information. After confirming your information, you can go into the online store and join the PTA.

New to Briarwood? Go to https://www.myschoolanywhere.com/join.a5w and enter the join code **BWBulldogs** then follow the directions to enter your information.

After confirming your information you will be taken to our shopping cart where you can join the Briarwood PTA or make a donation.

If you don't want your family's information included in the online and printed directories there is an opt-out option during the confirmation process, but we encourage you to at least enter an email address so that you receive messages from the PTA throughout the year.



Notes from Nurse Blizzard

Hi Briarwood Families,

My name is Beth Blizzard and I am excited to be the new nurse here at Briarwood. I'm thrilled to be a part of this great community and I appreciate the warm welcome I have received so far!

Our school wide dental screenings will be on Thursday September 6th. Health Partnership Clinic will be doing the screenings.

We will also be having school wide vision screenings on Wednesday September 12th. These are done using a spot vision screener through the Lion's Club.

If you have any questions about these screenings please contact me at elizabethblizzard@smsd.org or 913-993-2202.

To protect your student and prevent the spread of disease, please keep your student home when any of the following conditions are present:

- Temperature of 100 degrees or greater
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Severe sore throat or pain with swallowing
- Severe headache
- Severe cough
- Undiagnosed rash or skin lesions or sores that are weeping or draining
- Any suspected or doctor-diagnosed contagious disease

Students may return to school when they have been free from fever (without medication), vomiting, or diarrhea for 24 hours.

Students should be checked by the school nurse after head lice treatment before returning to class.
